## English

Any course in the Mathematics department at or above the 100-level is accepted for Math credit. Running Start tuition only covers college-level coursework (100-level or above). NOTE: a 5-credit SVC course below the 100 level earns .5 credit on HS transcript, rather than 1.0 credit.
