

PARENTAL REFUSAL TO PROVIDE INFORMATION

(For Unsubsidized Federal Direct Loan Consideration)

Financial aid regulations state that families are primarily responsible for covering their students' educational expenses. Dependent students must provide their parents' information and signatures on the FAFSA to be considered for financial aid. However, if parents refuse to provide this information, students may be eligible to apply for an Unsubsidized Loan, but this is subject to approval by a financial aid administrator.

If your parents won't provide their information on the FAFSA and also refuse to support you financially, please complete and submit this form. This will allow you to apply for an Unsubsidized Federal Direct Loan pending approval from a financial aid administrator. The Federal Direct Loan Application can be found on the financial aid website under "Federal Direct Loan".

If your parents are unwilling to sign a statement confirming their refusal, you will need to obtain documentation from a third party, such as a teacher, counselor, clergy member, or court representative.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. When submitting the FAFSA, select "I am submitting my FAFSA to apply for an unsubsidized loan only."
- 2. Complete this form by filling out one of the two options below.
- 3. Submit this completed form to Skagit Valley College's Financial Aid Office.

OPTION 1: PARENT STATEMENT
