


Thresholds:

CCSSE Pluralism Index score will be equal to or exeed the index score for similar-sized colleges.


Equity and Guiding Principle answers will average 75 percent positive responses.



SVC students engaged in a culture of mutual respect and acceptance that embraced diversity and promoted a civil society more than students attending similar-sized colleges.




The Pluralism Index is derived from seven measures, including ways students engage with fellow students of different races/ethnicities.




Other elements of the Pluralism Index include students developing a personal code of values and ethics, and contributing to the welfare of the community.

SVC Vision and Services Survey



SVC employees gave the College a 93% positive score for being guided by a set of shared principles -- 18 percentage points higher than the threshold.

SVC Vision and Services Survey



SVC employees gave the College an 92% positive score for being committed to equity -- 17 percentage points higher than the threshold.

The College will collaborate with its communities through the exchange of knowledge and resources.


Indicator:

Gelmon/Carnegie scores will average 75% of the maximum score.


Gelmon/Carnegie Community Engagement Assessment



SVC employees rated the College 3 out of 4 for promoting community engagement through its Strategic Plan -- meeting the 75% threshold.




Gelmon/Carnegie Community Engagement Assessment
