





Transfer Student Success After One Year - Fall 2016 Cohort




Transfer Student Success After One Year - 2016 Cohort




Transfer Student Success After Two Years - Fall 2015 Cohort





Transfer Student Success After Two Years - Trend Line



Workforce Student Success After One Year - Fall 2016 Cohort


SVC's Workforce success measures after one year are a the System.

Students will successfully transition to the workforce


Indicators:

Transition rate of completers


Threshold:

2015-16 Workforce Completer Employment Rates



SVC Completers* had a 1 percentage point higher employment rate than their peers CTC system. *Students completed a degree or certificate in 2015-16 and were employed in 2016-17 within 9 months of leaving the College.

Objective 3:

Students will demonstrate significant learning related to general education requirements


Indicator:


ETS Standardized Test Scores - % scoring as Proficient or Approaching Proficient.

Threshold:

Students will demonstrate general education learning gains based on the previous years' ETS scores.

Reading - Spring 2017 Transfer and Workforce Students





The percentage SVC students measured as proficient in writing increased by 11% points; the total percentage decreased by 3% points.

Math - Spring 2017 Transfer and Workforce Students 100% 90% 70% 80% 63% 70% 19% 60% 50% 26% Approaching Proficient Proficient 40% 30% 51% 20% 37% 10% 0% Fall 2015 (n=1151) Spring 2017 (n=426) The percentage of SVC students measured as proficient in math increased by 14% points; the total percentage increased by 7% points.

In Summary

Degree seeking SVC students demonstrate achievement rates above the System average.

SVC Workforce students are finding employment at rates higher than the System.

SVC students are gaining the Writing, Reading, and Math skills needed for successful transfer and/or employment.
