In order to provide comparable information to last year's report, Skagit Valley College has utilized consistent reporting methods, where possible, as described below:

Regarding student enrollment reporting, IPEDS non-degree seeking students = NWCCU unclassified students AND IPEDS degree seeking students = NWCCU undergraduate students.

All student enrollment data was taken from the IPEDS Fall\_Enrollment\_Data Survey for 2017-18. Each full-time student was counted as 1 FTE. The headcounts of part-time students was multiplied by the NWCCU's part-time equivalent coefficient (i.e., Public 2-year and <2-year (.335737)) in order to determine the part-time student FTE. Full-Time Equivalent FTES = Full-time student FTES + Part-time student FTES.

Full-Time Enrollment + Part-Time Enrollments = Total Undergraduate Unduplicated Headcounts

All faculty headcount and FTE data was taken from the IPEDS\_Human\_Resources\_Data Survey for 2017-18. On that survey, there is a total FTE for instructional employees (i.e., faculty). Each full-time faculty member was counted as 1 FTE. The difference between the total faculty FTE and the full-time faculty FTE = the part-time faculty FTE.

The 2011 graduation rate information was taken from the IPEDS\_Graduation\_Rates\_Data Survey for 2017-18. NOTE: Since Skagit Valley College started offering its first applied baccalaureate degree during 2014-15, the college is now classified as a 4-yr institution for IPEDS purposes (even though the college only has two 4-year degrees). As a result of the change, according to IPEDS, the graduation and transfer rates for 2-yr institutions are no longer available, and IPEDS reports Skagit Valley College's rates from a 4-yr institution perspective (i.e., 150% grad rate = 6 years). In reality, however, Skagit Valley College's data reflects 150% grad rate = 3 years because the college does not have first-time, full-time, degree-seeking Bachelor's-level students. As a result, Skagit Valley College has reported the 2011 cohort graduate rate in both the 2-yr and 4-yr sections. The reason for reporting the same data in two different locations is because that the data accurately reflects the 150% graduation rate for a 2-yr institution, but IPEDS reports the data as the 150% graduation rate for a 4-yr institution.

Because of the new IPEDS classification, a retention rate for 2016 cohort is also not available because Skagit Valley College did not have a baccalaureate cohort in 2016.

For the Institutional Finances section, Skagit Valley College is a GASB Institution and will follow the guidance from NWCCU: Expenses were taken from line 19 of section C-1 of the IPEDS report.

Operational Deficit was calculated in accordance with NWCCU guidance for GASB institutions.
