

## **Unemployment Rate and FTEs**



Historically, as the unemployment rate in Skagit County dips, so does SVC enrollment. Efforts in 2015-16 resulted in increased enrollment despite declining unemployment. However, low unemployment rates continue to suppress enrollment.




Meet or exceed State FTE Allocation and International SEM targets.

## **State Allocation and Actual FTEs**



SVC

SVC enrolled 92% of the 2017-18 state-funded allocation target.



SVC enrolled 101% of the International FTE target.

### Indicator


SVC District participation rate compared to the CTC System participation rate.

## **Participation Rate**



Participation Rate: The number of persons age 18-44 years enrolled as a percent of the relevant population.

SVC's participation rate is consistently 1 percentage point higher than the CTC system.

## Objective 3


The College enrollment will reflect District demographics.

# Threshold district. district. Parity between population and enrollment for student subpopulations.


#### Latino Students Compared to District Population

These adults are ages 18 to 64, excluding Running Start students.


### **4-Year Trend of Latino Enrollments**



### SVC continues a high enrollment of Latino students.



### 4-Year Trend of Degree-Seeking Latino Enrollments




SVC enrolled the same percentage of Latino degreeseeking students as 2014-15.


#### **CCB Students Compared to District Population**



SVC enrolled an equal percentage of CCB students compared to community's percentage of adults ages 18-44 with no high school diploma or GED.




### **4-Year Trend of CCB Enrollments**




### Enrollment in CCB continues a steady increase.

# In Summary



- SVC state-supported enrollment is reflective of decreased unemployment rates and state-wide enrollment trends.
- SVC continues to serve a higher percentage of Latinos than the district population.
- Enrollment of students who report being of multiple races increased in 2017-18.
