



SVC's CCB student transition rate to collegelevel classes is 17 percentage points higher than CCB students across the CTC system.

SVC CCB students transitioned to college-level classes at a rate greater than the CTC system for the past 4 years.

Students will demonstrate level gains in Basic Skills.

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


SVC CCB and ELA students will meet or exceed the SVC four-year rolling average.

# In Summary

# SVC

- SVC CCB students transitioned at significantly higher rates in 2017-18 and were 17 points higher than the System average.
- While CCB students made gains in terms of total SAI points in 2017-18, Basic Skills gains were below the fouryear average.

- ELA students continue to show progress in terms of their Basic Skills gains.
- With our current and new initiatives, SVC will continue to support BEDA students transitioning to college level courses.
