## **Placement Guidelines**

For Math placement, we accept high school transcripts from across Washington State. Out of state and international transcripts are not eligible for Math placement determinations.

There is no averaging of grades. A student with an A and C in each semester of a year-long course would not be eligible for placement in a course that requires "at least B (each semester)." A student with an A and a B in each semester of a year-long course would look at "at least B (each semester)" placement.

If you are not eligible for placement based on your High School transcript, you can complete the Accuplacer Assessment.
