









LatinX Completion of college-level English by first year








Transfer Student Completion of 45 college-level credits After Two Years




Workforce Student Completion of 45 college-level credits After Two Years







LatinX ELA Student Success After Two Years







LatinX Transfer Students Who Complete Degrees or Certificates Within Three Years








LatinX Workforce Students Who Complete Degrees or Certificates Within Three Years



LatinX BEdA Students who Transition to College-Level Classes Within Two Years



In Summary



- Retention and completion rates are trending up
- SVC has developed clear measures to document equity gaps involving LatinX students. While we are focusing on closing these gaps, the retention and completion rates for LatinX students is trending up
- BEdA students are significantly outperforming the system average for transitions to college
- The college has extensively revised its general education program and implemented comprehensive program review to better assess and improve student learning outcomes
