AHS Math Requirements - Students who place below 100 level in Math may opt for one of two options:

1. Enroll in a math course 1st period at AHS, schedule permitting. **OR**
2. Pay to enroll in a non-college (below 100) level course at SVC.
 MTH 96 = Pre-Algebra, MTH 97 = Algebra I, MTH 98 = Alg. I/Alg. II, MTH 99 = Algebra II

AHS Graduation Requirements

- This includes meeting the State English and Math Exam requirements, as well as the State Science Exam for the Class of 2021+
- Full time Running Start students must also complete the AHS Advisory requirements through one of the SVC courses listed in that section above.
- To participate in the AHS Commencement Ceremony, seniors must be enrolled in at least 12 credits winter and spring quarters.
