






Fall-to-Winter retention will meet or exceed the system average.

LatinX Fall-to-Winter Retention




Fall-to-Fall Retention




Fall-to Fall retention will meet or exceed the system average.




Completion of College-Level English by First Year




Completion of college-level English by the first year will meet or exceed the system average.

LatinX Completion of College-Level English by First Year




Completion of College-Level Math by First Year






LatinX Transfer Student Completion of 45 College-Level Credits


