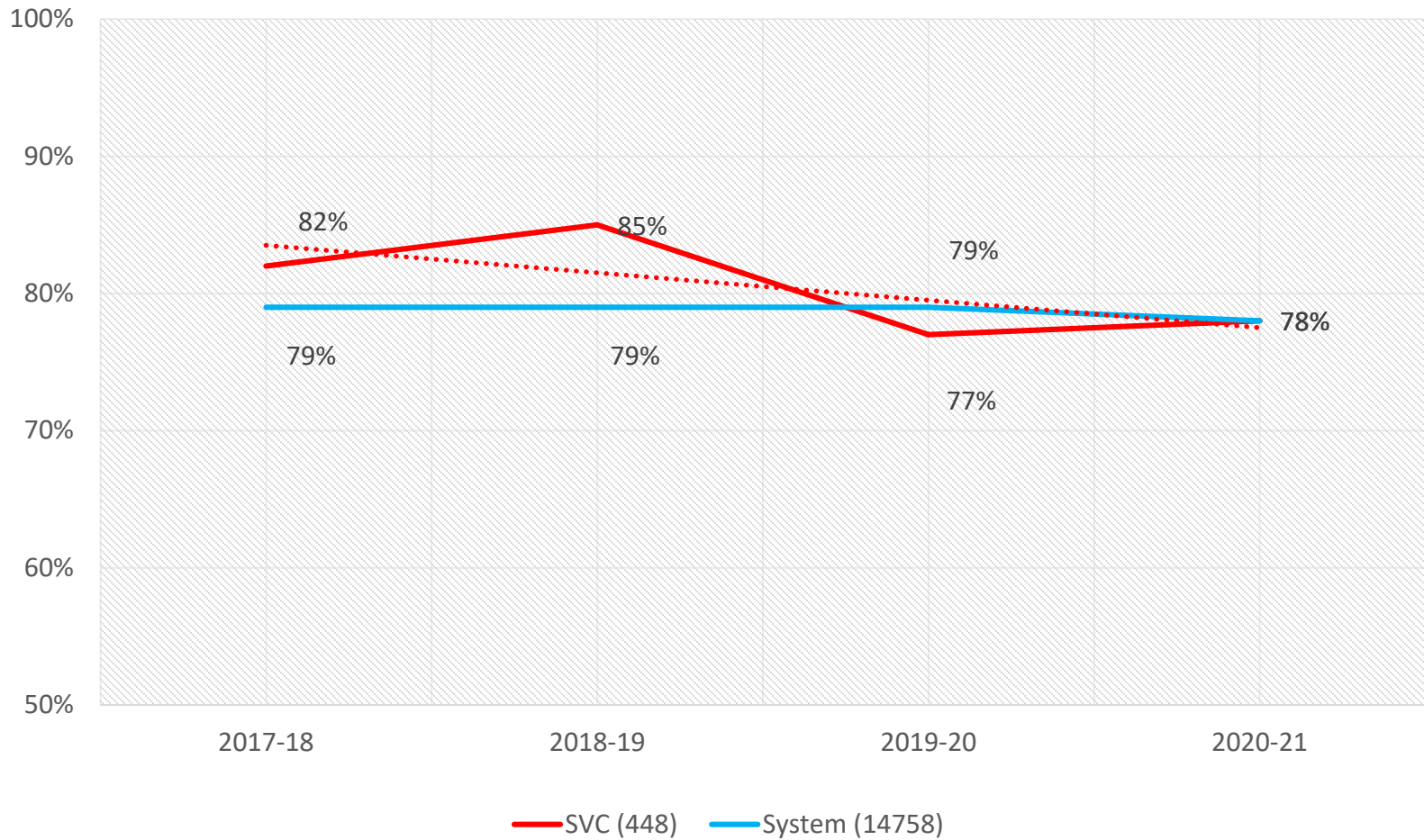

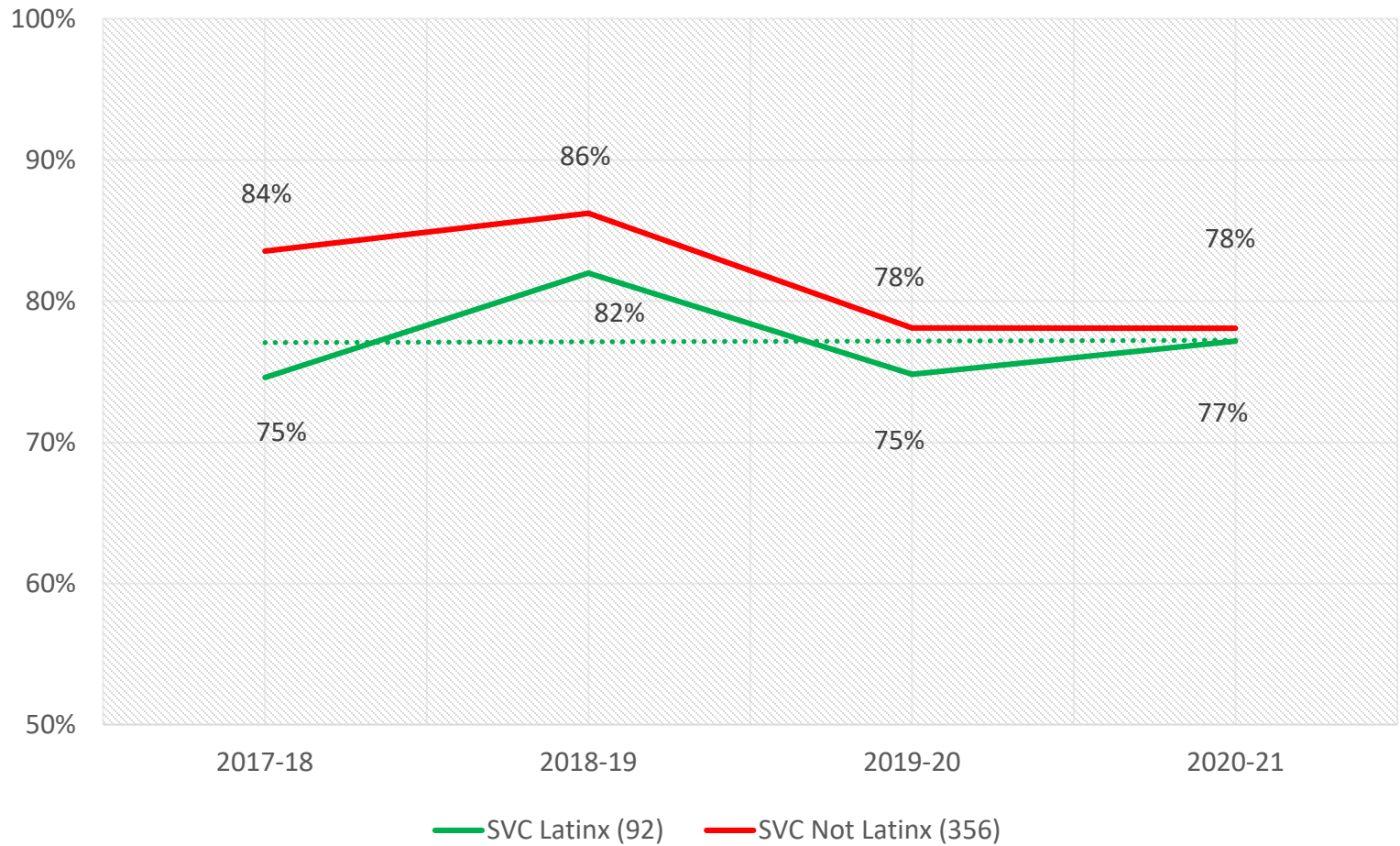
Fall-to-Winter Retention



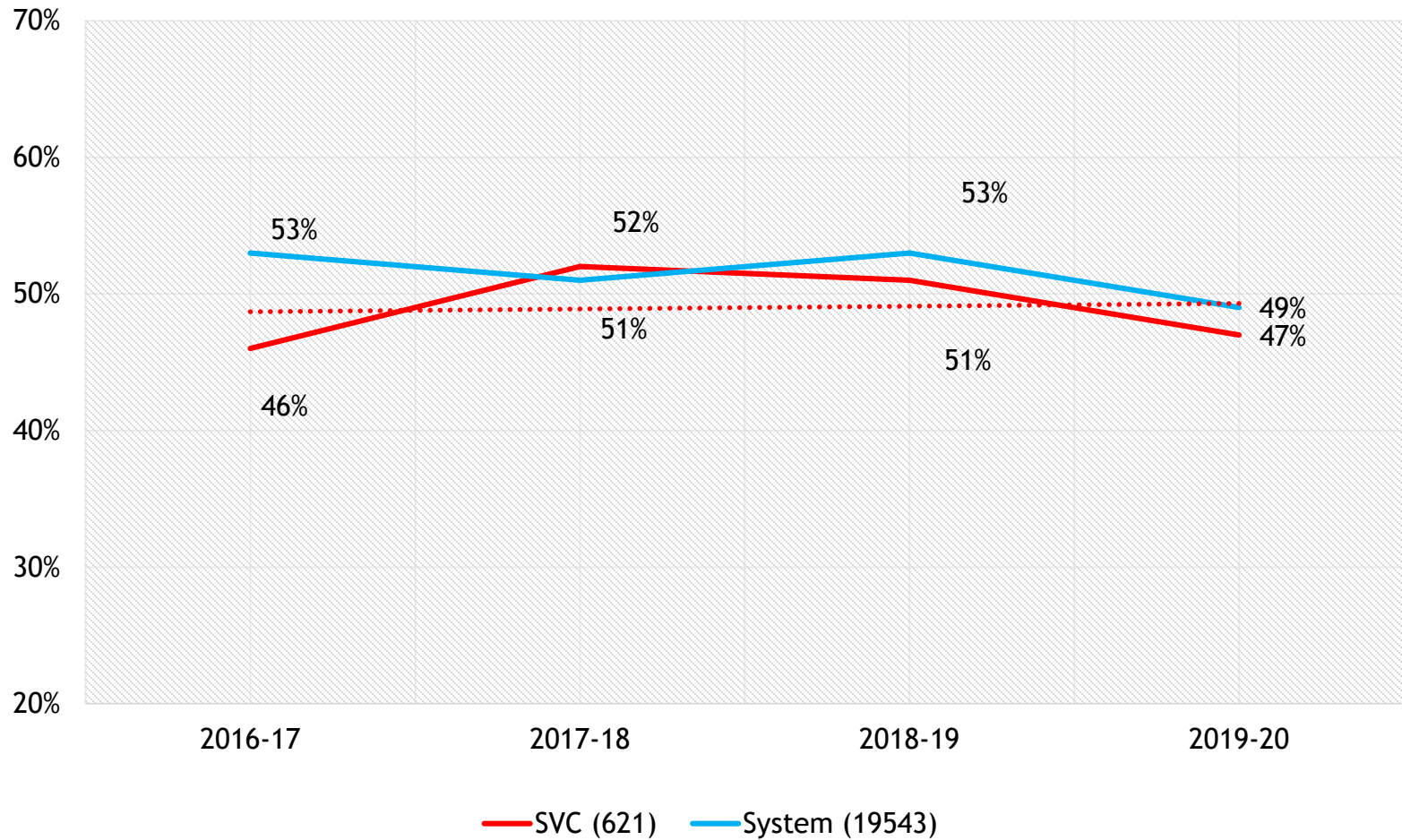
Fall-to-Winter retention will meet or exceed the system average.



LatinX Fall-to-Winter Retention



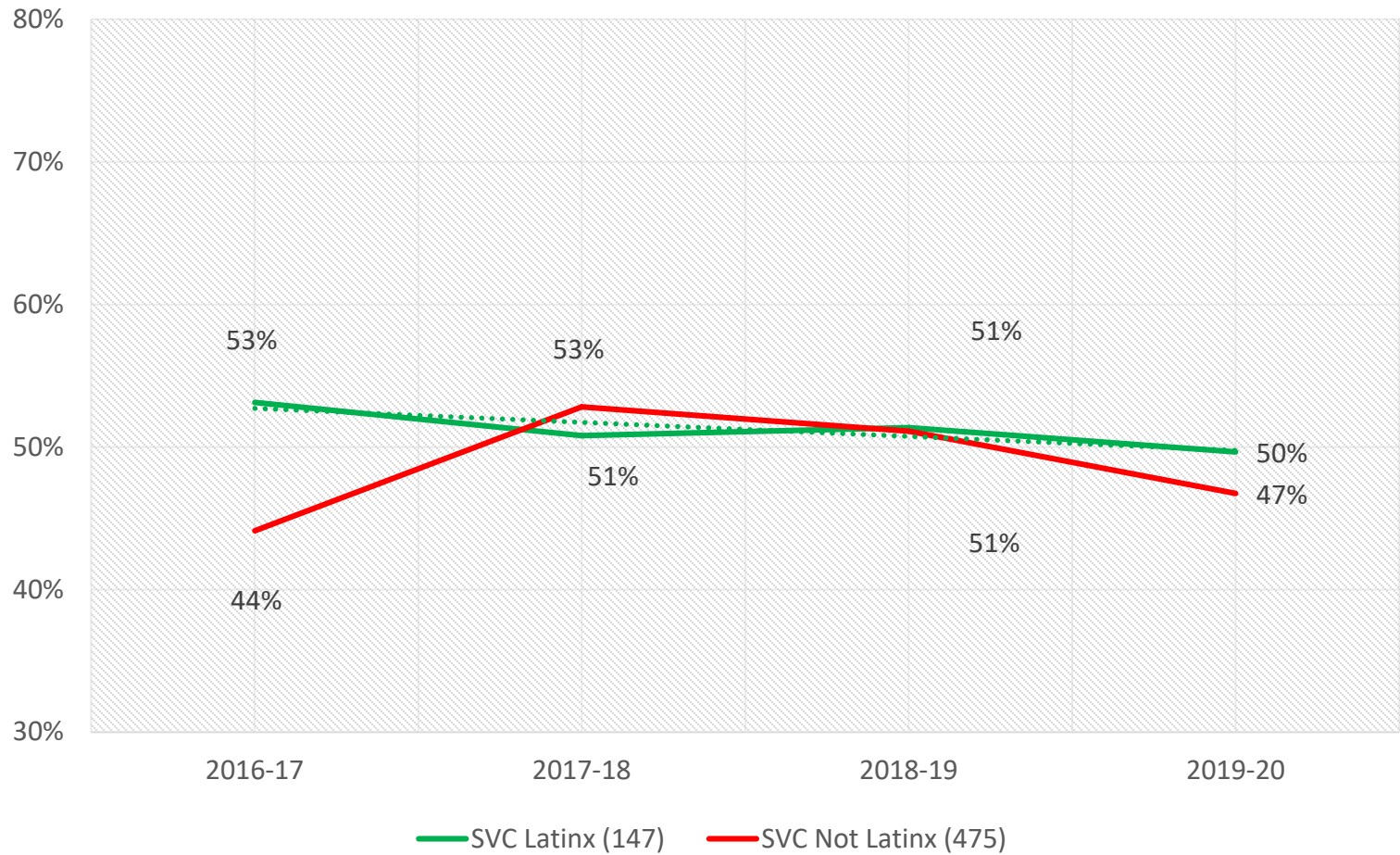

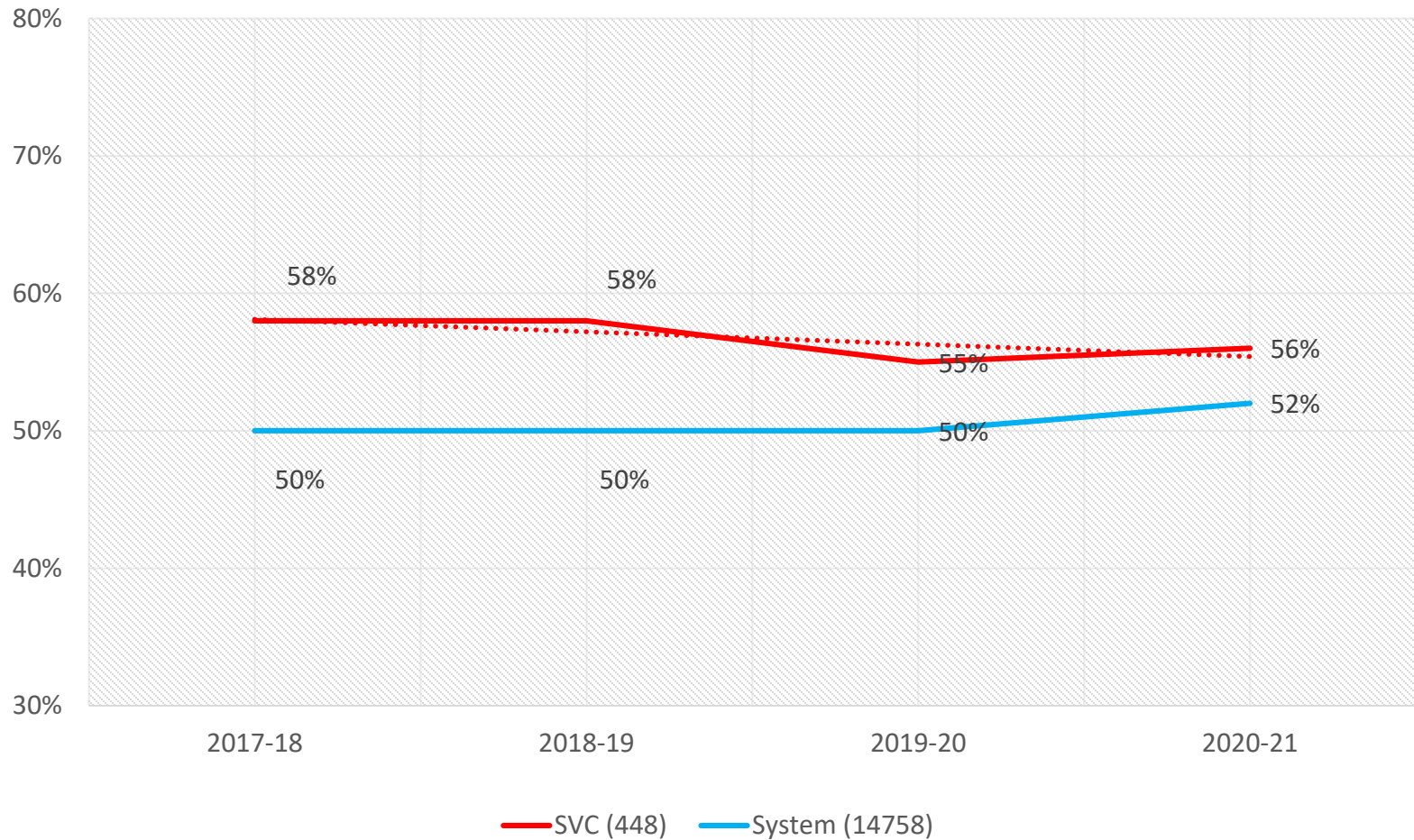

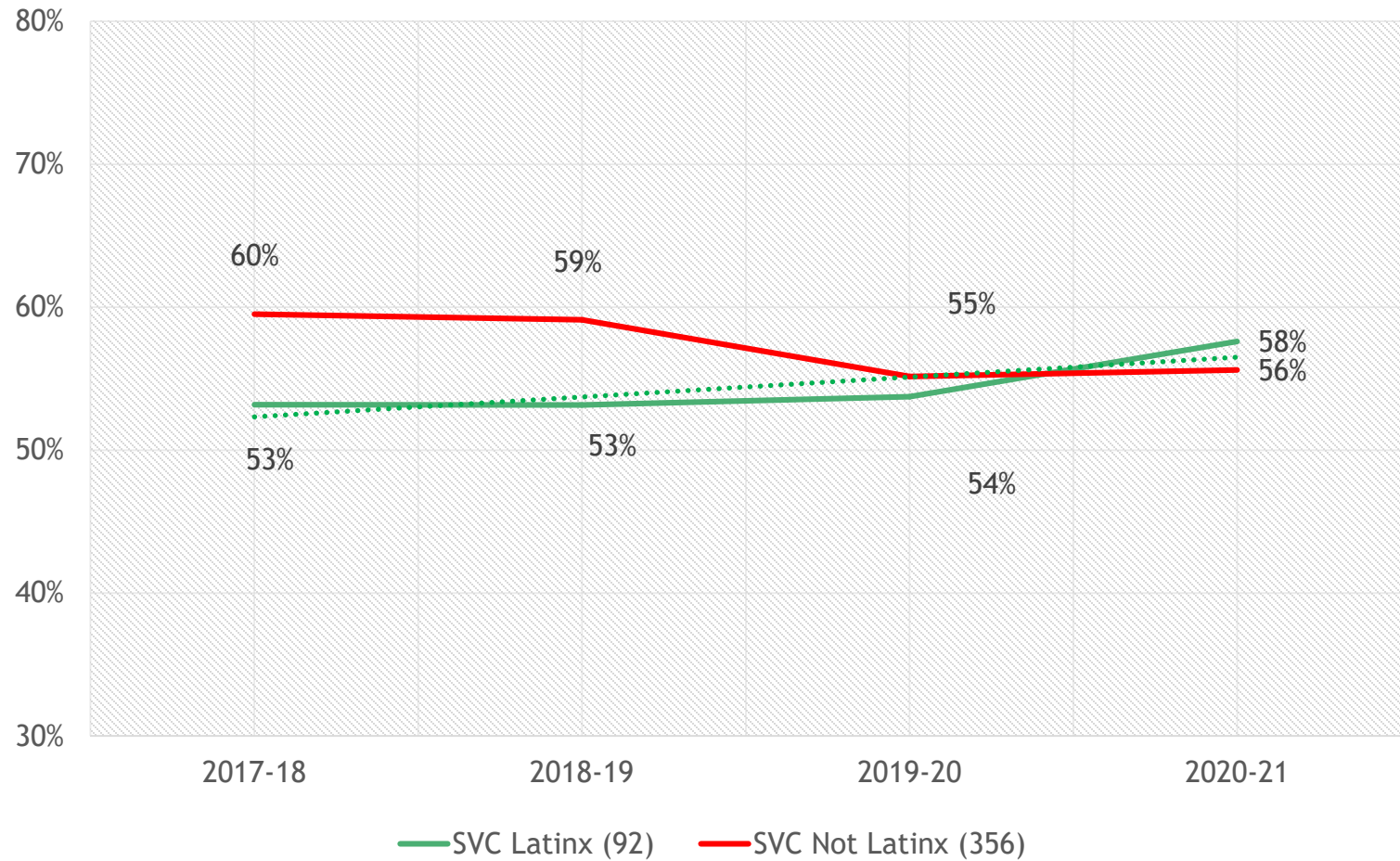
Completion of College-Level English by First Year



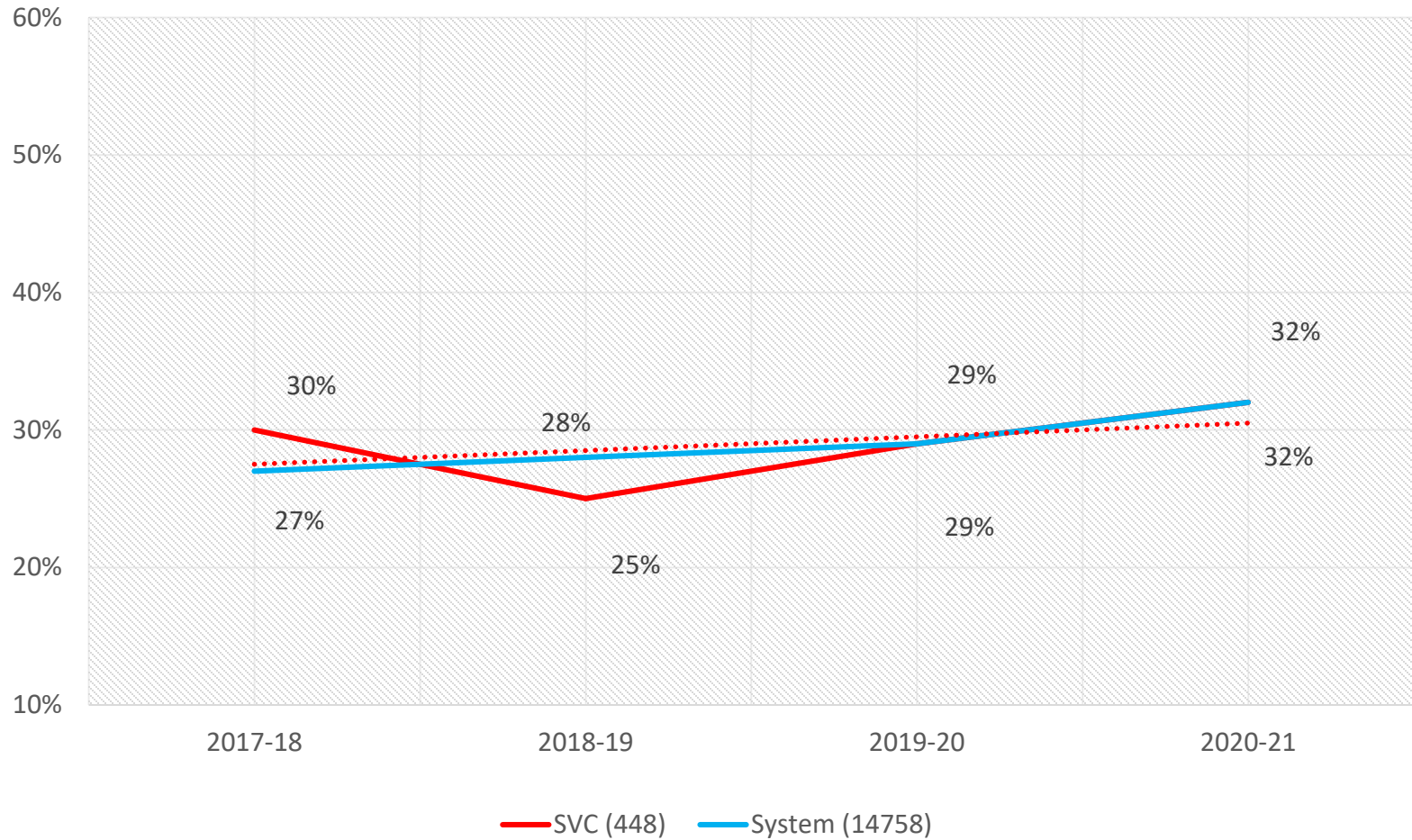
Completion of college-level English by the first year will meet or exceed the system average.



LatinX Completion of College-Level English by First Year



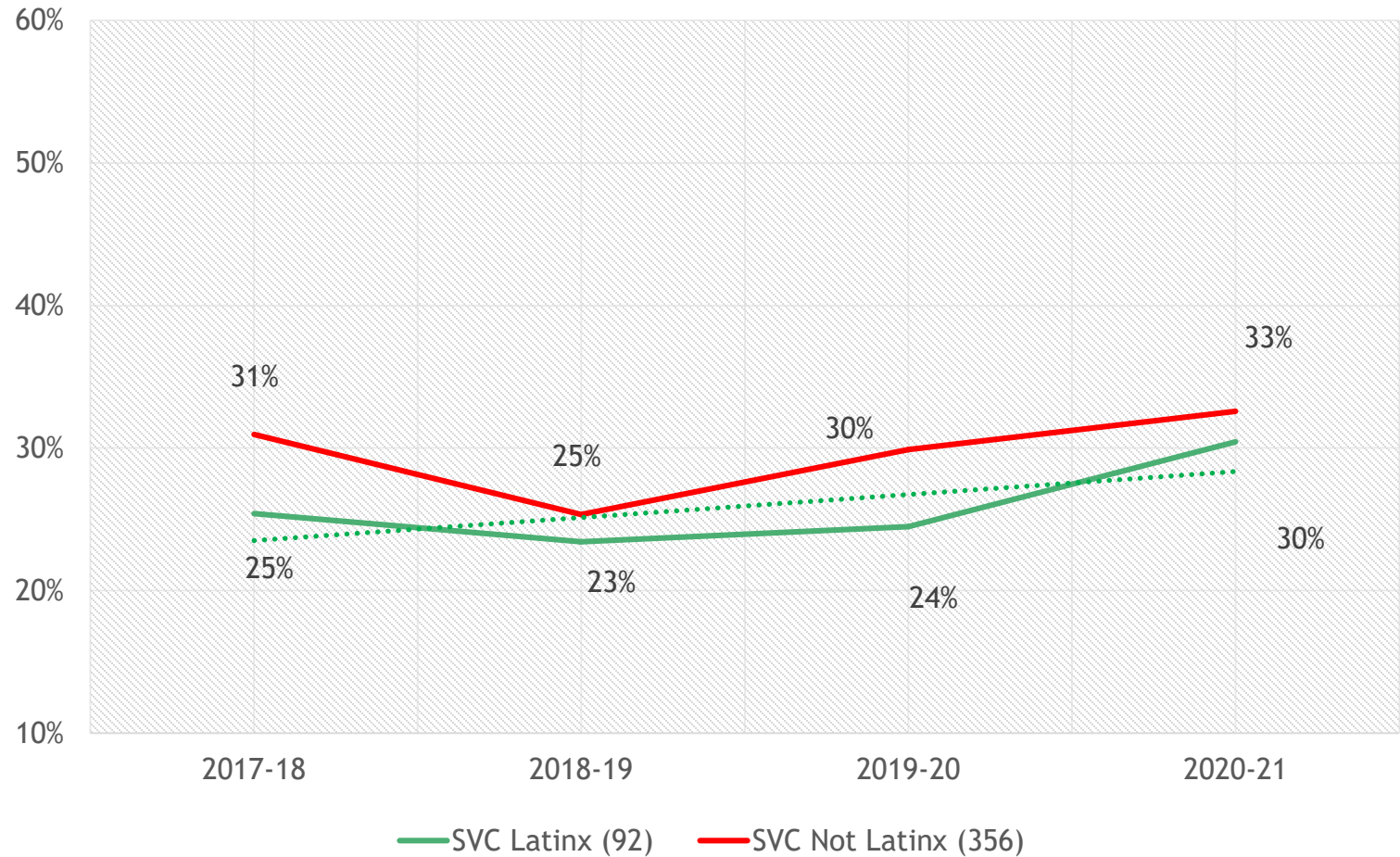
Completion of College-Level Math by First Year

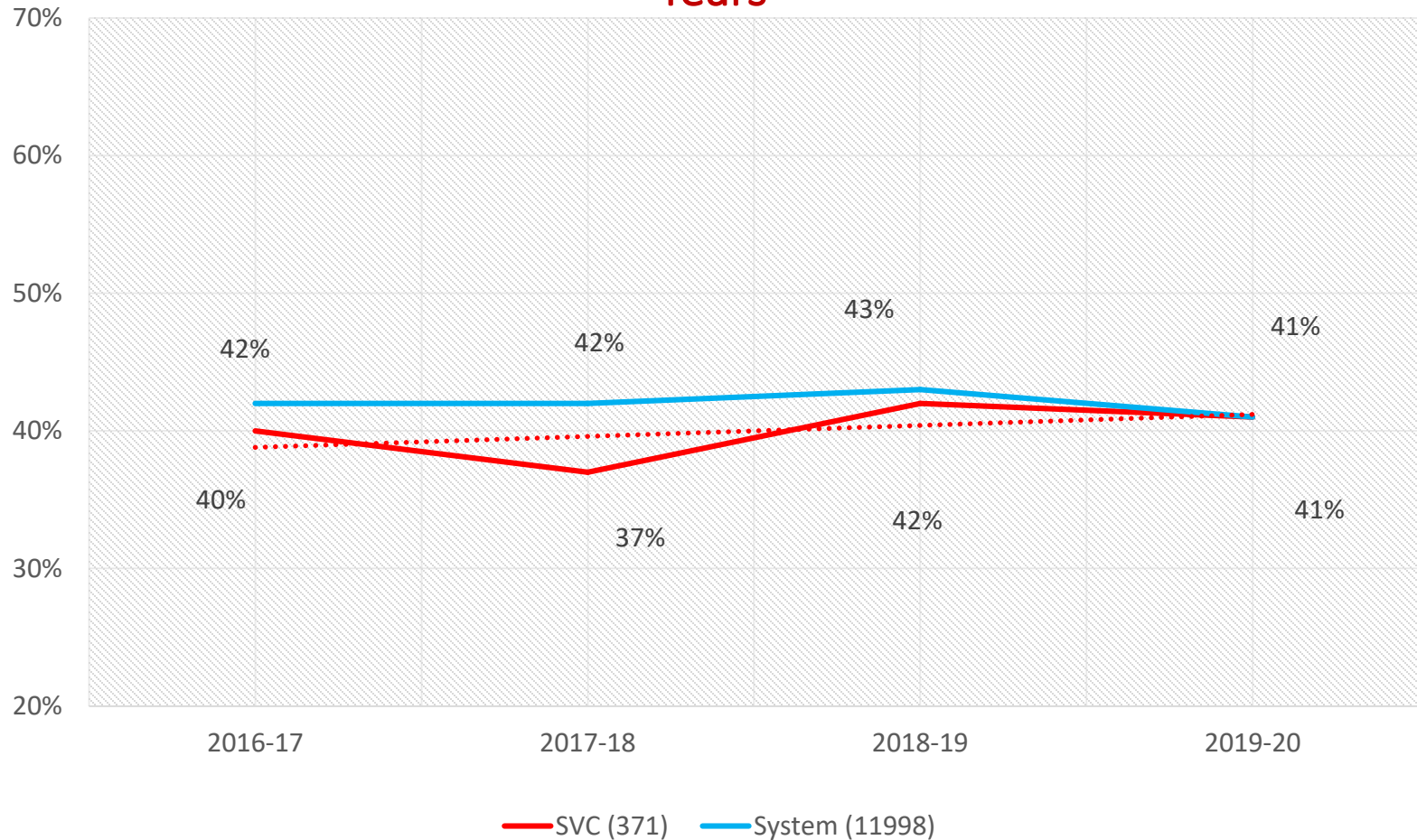

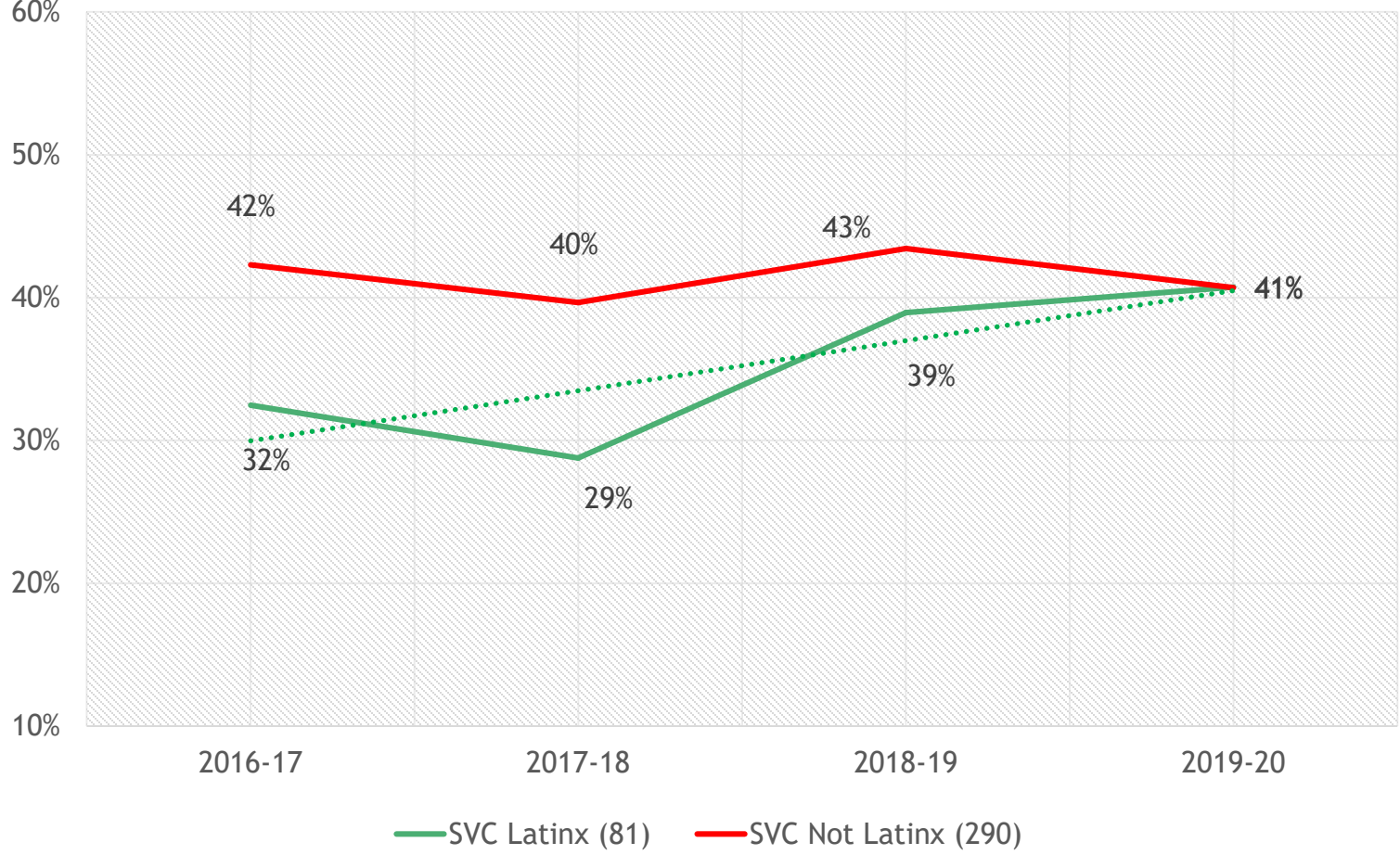
Transfer Student Completion of 45 College-Level Credits after Two Years



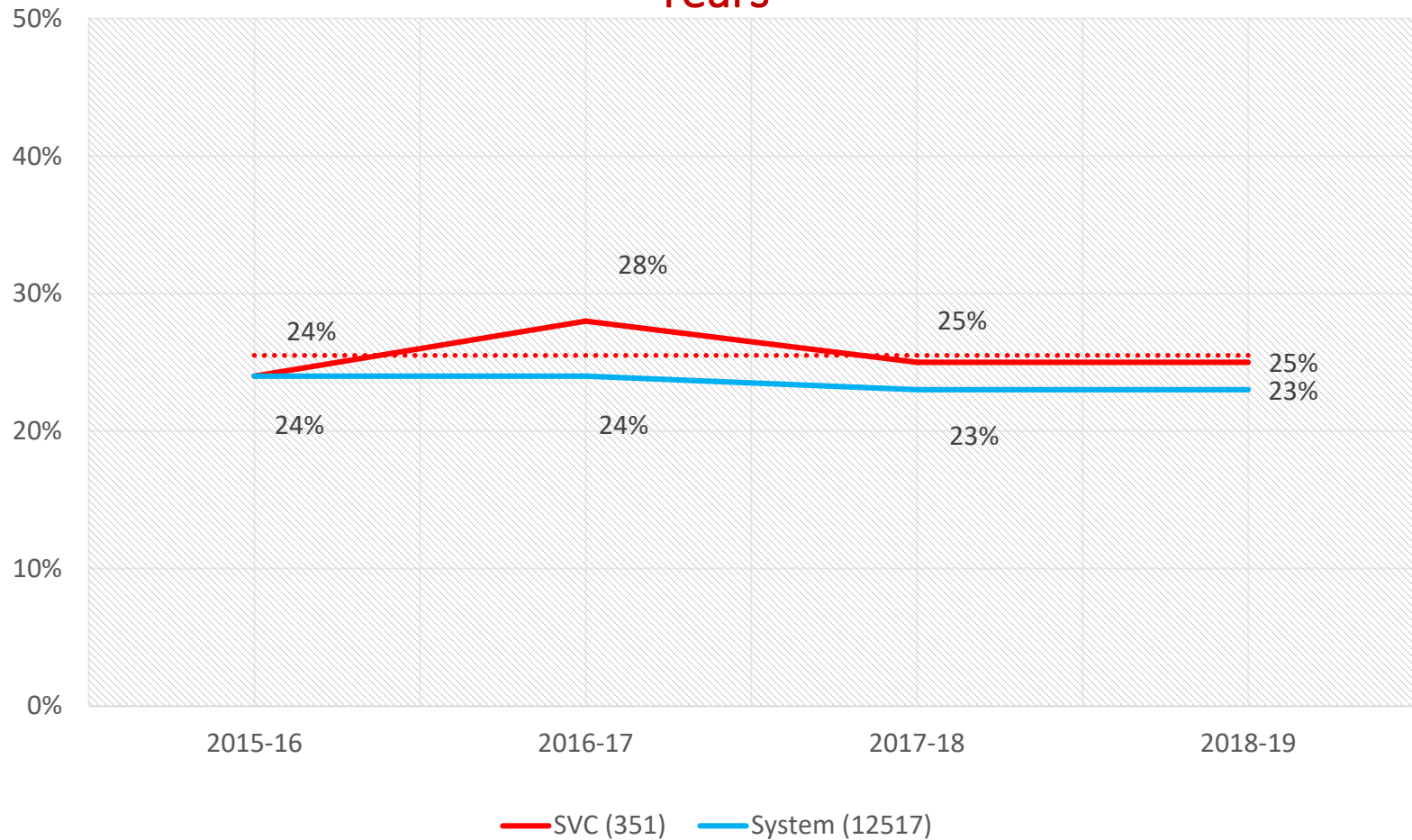

LatinX Transfer Student Completion of 45 College-Level Credits after Two Years



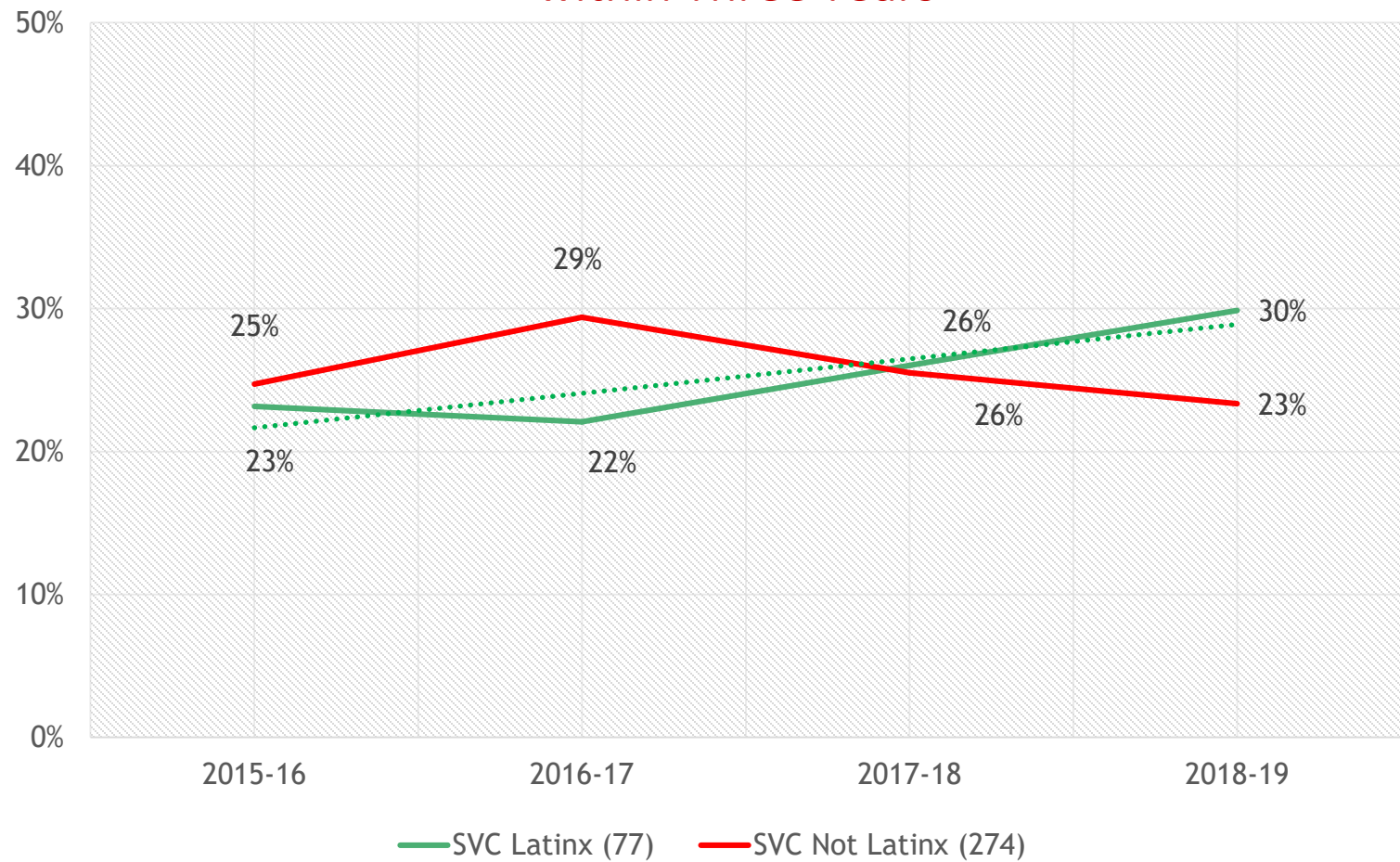
Transfer Students Who Complete Degrees or Certificates within Three Years

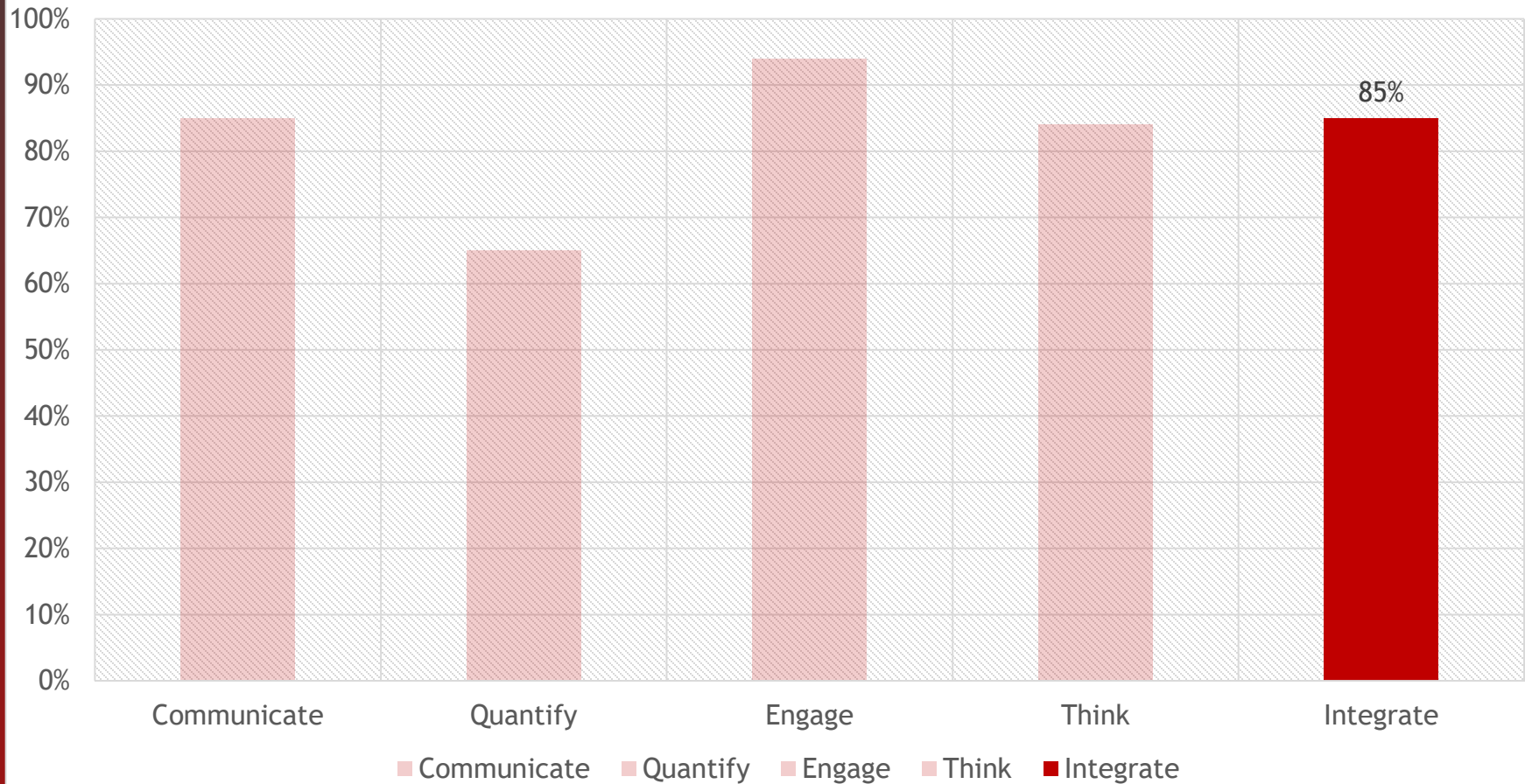
