






SVC Workforce student cohort measures will meet or exceed the CTC system average.



LatinX Workforce Student Completion of 45 College-Level Credits After Two






LatinX Workforce Students Who Complete Degrees or Certificates Within Three Years






Percentage of Workforce students who become employed exceeds the system average



Core Theme Achievement BEdA




- Current Board Indicators of Effectiveness for BEdA students utilize the CASAS Test
